 - Monthly processing charges by the county treasurer
- Community outreach
 - o Expenses related to community involvement. Mailers, flyers, contributions to local events
- Compliance
 - Any expense related to mandated requirements. Fees related to ambulance certification and licensure, etc.
- District Management & Accounting
 - Community Resource Services (CRS) monthly services (monthly financial reports) and any other related expenses (budget prep, election filings, etc.)
- Dues and Subscriptions
 - Annual / Periodic expenses: Office 365, Quicken, FreCom, business Prime, Special District Association.
- Insurance
 - (Not currently using- may delete)
- Legal
 - Legal advice, assistance (paid by the hour)
- Office equipment & technology
 - o Printers & supplies, electronic whiteboard, PC accessories, etc.
- Payroll Taxes
 - Payroll Expenses (Fed & state withholding, SS taxes, disability, etc.) related to Admin Staff reimbursement / Payroll
- Postage
 - Postage, shipping fees
- Printing
 - o Printing costs for manuals, training materials, etc.

Operations

- Bank Charges
 - Debit card fees
- Billing and collection fees
 - o Business Options fees related to medical billing
- Cleaning and sanitation
 - Sanitizers and general cleaning supplies
- Communications
 - o Active 911 subscriptions, Med-1 cell services
- Dispatch Services
 - Quarterly dispatch services (FreCom)
- Facility Reimbursements
 - o Donations to HVFD for bay use and Med unit storage
- Insurance
 - Workman's comp, ambulances, liability
- Medical device maintenance
 - Maintenance/repair charges for Lifepacs, cots, loaders, Lucas, etc.
- Medical supplies
 - o Med supplies used in day to day operations
- Operating contingency
 - Mandated 3% reserve for emergency use.
- Personal protection equipment
 - o Gloves, masks, hand sanitizer, sanitizing sprays, cleaners, etc.
- Transport expenses
 - o Expenses related to patient transports
- Uniforms
 - Shirts, pants, gloves, jackets, etc. Safety gear/vests
- Volunteer benefits
 - o ATT reimbursements, Salia Clinic memberships, volunteer outings, etc.
- Volunteer responder reimbursements
 - Challenge shift payouts volunteer assistance.

Training

- Continuing education
 - Expenses related to EMT continuing education required for advancement and ongoing (re)certification
- Driver Training (EMR)
 - Training expenses related to training drivers
- EMT Training
 - o Training expenses related to training EMTs: cost of classes, books, exams and tests.
- Training devices, supplies & books
 - o Costs associated with general training items: mannikins, training tools, etc.
- Training equipment small
 - o Miscellaneous small equipment related to general training.

Equipment

- Ambulance computers
 - o Items related to the computers in the ambulances: replacement cables, pens, chargers, etc.
- Ambulance Fuel
 - o Diesel fuel for the ambulances
- Ambulance maintenance
 - o Maintenance and repairs to the ambulances
- Ambulance registration and licensing
 - o Registration fees, annual licensing and certification fees
- Communications
 - o Portable communications equipment and supplies: radios, cases, batteries, mice, etc.
- Facility
 - o Storage boxes, shelving, cabinets, etc.
- Small equipment
 - Any small equipment purchased not falling into another, specific category: vacuum cleaner, pressure washer, Lifepak mounting system, etc.
